Shows off a deep and complex array of dark fruit, florals notes and mineral aromas. In the mouth, this has a wonderful, dense core of cassis, cocoa and complex herbs set in a seductively textured framework. Beautiful balance of refined power, luxurious texture and silky tannins.

Together they are an incredibly refined, powerful and seductive Cabernet blend.
